TORBAY ROAD RELAYS

RULES

All teams to be declared by 6.45p.m. using an event entry form and completed by a nominated club/team representative. This means that all entries on the day and any changes to entered teams must be made before 6.45p.m.

No new entries will be allowed, and the declared running order of teams is not be changed once the event has started.

Club colours/vests must be worn

Numbers are to be worn on the front of running kit and not be cut folded or mutilated

Letter on race number indicates the relevant leg to be run

Leg handover is to be carried out within the coned section at the end of each out and back leg under the direction of the Race Director

Athletes can only count in one team competing for prizes

Veteran teams require all members to be in the same age group or from an older age group.

The wearing of headphones during the race is strictly prohibited. Any team member seen wearing headphones during their leg will result in team disqualification

Scratch teams can be made up of any combination of runners (age and gender), including runners who have competed in a previous leg. These teams will be included in the results, but will not be eligible for a prize

Only one prize per team

The Referee's decision is final
