It is against the rules to give your number to a non-entered runner. Please complete the details on the rear of the number for emergency reasons.

FOR YOUR SAFETY AND THAT OF ALL RUNNERS STRICTLY NO MUSIC HEADPHONES AND EARPHONES DURING THE RACE. Runners ignoring this rule will be disqualified.
