If so, we will notify you before the start of the race

Food (cash please): The Trotters are renowned for their amazing cakes, of which there will be a wide selection to choose from, as well as teas and coffees. We will also have a BBQ selling hot dogs and burgers. Suffice to say you won't go hungry!

Race Safety: The route outside the school grounds is mainly on trails with some short sections on local lanes. The course will be clearly marked with arrows and tape as well as plenty of marshals to ensure you don't take a wrong turn.

There are two drink stations on the course. We will be using recyclable cups. Please do not leave any litter on the course.

Please respect others on the course. Remember you don't have priority in public areas. The section around Stover Park will be busy, especially if it's a nice day.

Race cut off: If you fail to make the 5-mile cut off point in 70 minutes you will be asked to withdraw from the race and give your race number to the marshal. A lift back to the finish will be provided.
