## Points mean Prizes

I'm amazed how often I'm asked about how our points system works! It's pretty simple really, the more you marshal the greater the rewards on offer. Each time you marshal/help at a race you get a point. If you bake three cakes during the year for our races, you also get a point. The maximum number of points you can get during the year is six. Here's a breakdown of what's on offer.

2 points ~ Free Club Championship race (this year it was the Ottery 10K)

4 points ~ A chance to be entered into a draw for one of 8 x £50 race entry vouchers

4 points ~ £10 discount per person, per night for the Club Camp, up to the value of £20

6 points ~ A chance to be entered into a draw for a London Marathon place

If you get the maximum points you are eligible for all the prizes on offer. Those with four points are eligible for all the prizes for four points and fewer. Those with two points are eligible for the two-point prize only.
